

## **TECHNICAL RIDER**

### **“SALTIMBANKO”**

#### **Description:**

What could happen if a jester of the past centuries, while manipulating crystal balls and balancing on a rope, would start throwing knives? And if in doing so he would also involve unsuspecting spectators? Will they end up being innocent victims or complicit partners? Discover it by yourself in a bewitching and compelling show, recreated according to the tradition and the style of the jesters of the Middle Ages.

Perfect for historical recallings and other medieval themed events.

#### **Duration:**

About 30 minutes.

#### **Preparation time:**

Assembling: about 20 minutes; disassembling: about 10 minutes.

#### **Technical requirements:**

It's needed a minimum space of 9x5 meters, in order to assemble the slack-rope structure reproduced below; it must be hooked onto two hooking points on the ground level, with a distance of about 10 meters (minimum 9 maximum 20) and a resistance of about 350Kg (for example: lamp-posts, columns, traffic lights, road signs, cement benches, trees, iron bars firmly planted in the ground, wall plugs fixed on the walls or on the stage, cement blocks with hooking ring, big plastic boxes filled with water or sand...).

Minimum height required: 4 meters.

A socket is needed in order to power lights and PA system; anyway, if there is no socket, it's also possible to use a battery-powered system, totally self-sufficient (in this case, it's required at least a properly illuminated performing spot).
